Celebrating a Quinceañera

I recently had the blessing of celebrating a quinceañera at St. Mary's for a young lady as she celebrated her 15th birthday. This was my first time being involved in a quinceañera; I had never even attended one before. I knew of them, though, and heard they were quite the celebration. So, when the family reached out to see about having this in Bethel, I was excited to learn more and, if able, to be a part of it.

For those who may not know, a quinceañera is a coming-of-age celebration for a 15-year-old woman. This is typically found in Latin American cultures. The celebrations include food, dancing, fancy dresses, and great joy. Oftentimes, for Catholics, they also include a religious element, either within or outside of Mass.

So, when I met with this particular family, they mentioned they wanted to have Mass as part of the celebration. One of my first questions, though, was "Can this be in English?" Since I don't know Spanish, I would not have been able to offer the Mass in that language. Thankfully, they said English was fine. So, after they explained how quinceañeras typically go, I readily agreed to help.

And, when the day came, I felt truly blessed to be able to celebrate the Mass and was moved by the experience. Within the celebration of Mass, there are some special elements that take place for the young woman and her family. These were very memorable for me. The opening procession takes place with the young woman, her parents, and godparents all participating. This shows the connection we are called to have with those who are given the task of helping us live our faith, even as we ourselves get older.

Most of the other special traditions take place immediately after the homily. First, the one who is turning 15 renews her baptismal promises, giving public witness to her faith. She then receives gifts, commonly including a Bible and a Rosary, showing the roles that the Word of God and our prayer life play in helping us mature, make good decisions, and truly live to serve the Lord. After receiving the gifts, the young woman then offers a gift – namely, her devotion to the Blessed Mother—

by placing flowers before her statue. This takes place oftentimes, as a Marian hymn, such as Ave Maria, is being sung. Again, this demonstrates our need to turn to Mary, as our mother, and ask for her intercession to help us navigate this life.

The rest of the Mass was fairly typical, with the usual, yet beautiful, ways the Church has given us to offer our worship to the Lord. But I will admit, since this was my first ever quinceañera, I wasn't always sure how things were to go within the Mass. This was okay, though, as God was praised and glorified; this young woman gave witness to her faith – while being surrounded and supported by her loved ones – and all those present were given the reminder of how blessed we are with the gift of life that God has given us.

This might be my biggest takeaway from this celebration – that gentle nudge to not forget gratitude. To take time each day to give God thanks for the gift of life, and then to seek to honor that gift by how I choose to live it in my relationship with Him. And this is good, not just for 15-year-old women to keep in mind, but for each and every one of us.

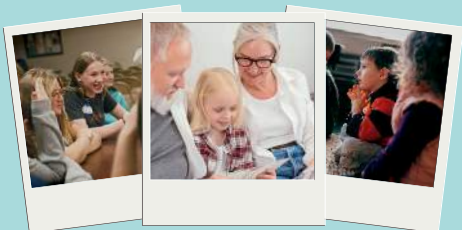

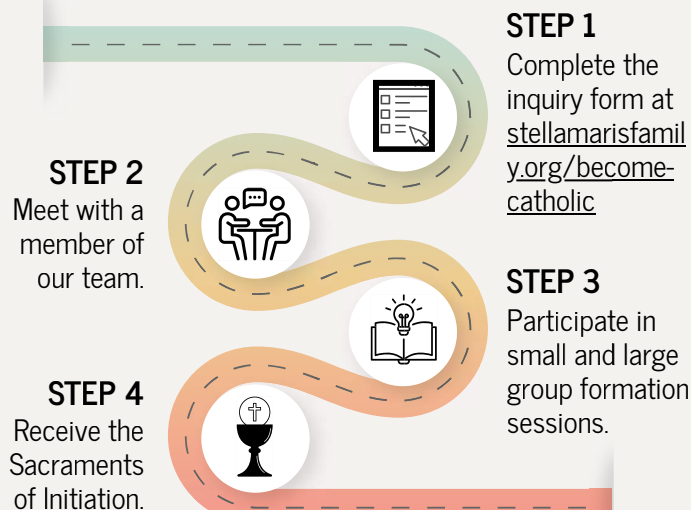

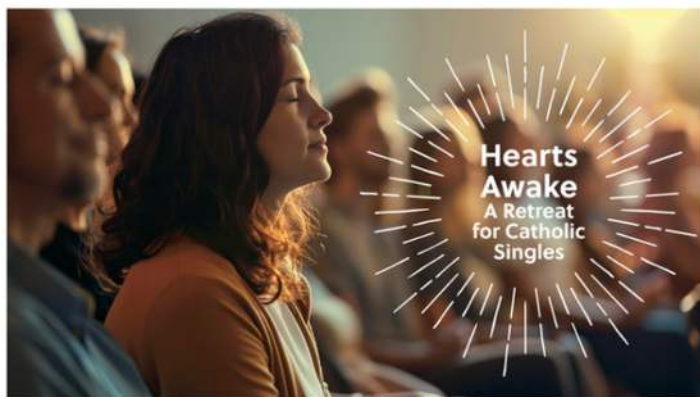
